

### Table of Recyclables Sorting

Type	Included	Excluded	Processing
<b>Paper</b>	Newspapers, photocopy paper, sheet paper, books, magazines	Toilet paper, sanitary napkins, paper cups, paper plates, paper lunch boxes (due to the oil or wax treatment), coated art paper, plastic coated glossy paper	Be sure to remove any tape or staplers or other stationary of different materials
<b>Can</b>	Tin cans, aluminum cans	aerosol canisters, straws	Empty contents of can and compress or crush
<b>Plastic</b>	Clean plastic bags, plastic made products	Unwashed items, Styrofoam	
<b>Bottle</b>	Plastic bottles, milk bottles and other bottles	straw	Empty contents
<b>Pack</b>	aluminum foil packs, drink boxes	straw	Empty contents and compress or crush
<b>Misc.</b>	Aerosol canisters, glass bottles, dry battery		Place in separate properly labeled paper box beside the recycling box
<b>Misc</b>	Styrofoam, fluorescent light tubes	Ceramic, clothe dolls, pillows	Place beside recycling box
<b>Computer</b>	Mainframe, monitor	Casing, disks, tapes, print tapes	
<b>Electronic</b>	Radios, electric fans	Audio tapes, video tapes	
<b>General Garbage</b>	all types of materials that are covered with inedible oils or dirt, such as plates, cups, utensils and used plastic bags		Place in disposal boxes other than recycling.

Note: Aerosol canisters include: Gas canisters, spray paint connectors, insecticide canisters.
