**NATIONAL TAIWAN UNIVERSITY**  
**Regulations for the Establishment of the Sustainable**  
**Development Promotion Committee**

October 12, 2021    Passed by the 3,104<sup>th</sup> Administrative Meeting  
March 07, 2023    Passed by the 3,141<sup>st</sup> Administrative Meeting  
March 21, 2023    Articles 1 through 5 amended and promulgated

- Article 1    National Taiwan University (NTU or “the University”) formulates the NTU *Regulations for the Establishment of the Sustainable Development Promotion Committee* (“the Regulations”) in order to establish the Sustainable Development Promotion Committee (“the Committee”) for the effective coordination of sustainable development initiatives across all administrative and academic units and to proclaim the University’s resolution to realize its vision of a future driven by sustainability.
- Article 2    The duties of the Committee are as follows:
1.    Developing University-wide sustainable development goals (SDGs) and strategies
  2.    Reviewing University-wide sustainable development action plans and conducting performance evaluation
  3.    Integrating achievements of interdepartmental sustainable development working teams
  4.    Handling matters assigned by the University Council
- Article 3    The Committee shall be composed of 13 to 17 members. The NTU President, an executive vice president, the Secretary-General, Vice President for Academic Affairs, Vice President for Student Affairs, Vice President for General Affairs, Vice President for Research and Development, Vice President for International Affairs, Director of the Office of Sustainability, and a student representative appointed by the NTU Student Association shall serve as ex officio members. The remaining seats shall be filled by faculty members specializing in a related field, staff members, and students appointed by the President at the recommendation of the Director of the Office of Sustainability. Appointed members shall serve part-time for a two-year term, with the possibility of consecutive terms if reappointed.
- Article 4    The NTU President shall serve as chair of the Committee.  
The chair shall call meetings at least once per year, and interim meetings may be called when necessary.
- Article 5    Administrative matters pertaining to the Committee shall be handled by the NTU Office of Sustainability.
- Article 6    The Regulations shall be passed by the Administrative Meeting and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
